Alfredo Rocco developed the economic and political theory of corporatism which would become part of the Fascist Manifesto of the National Fascist Party. Rocco denounced the European powers for imposing</p>	<p>foreign culture on Italy and criticized the European powers for endorsing too much liberalism and individualism.
