La presse rock française des années 90 reste attachée à la médiation (issue des années 60-70) rock - rébellion de la jeunesse. Mais cette musique n'est plus exclusivement appréciée

par les jeunes (qui souvent préfèrent d'autres styles, tandis que les anciens jeunes font valoir leur droit à l'apprécier) et apparaît de plus en plus soumise aux logiques économiques (donc éloignées des positions contre-culturelles originelles). Ceci impose aux rédacteurs d'ouvrir leur compréhension du rock et de la jeunesse à de nouvelles définitions plus en accord avec l'époque : acceptation de la musique électronique, du vieillissement dans le rock, etc. Outre cette transformation de leur sujet d'analyse, les journalistes sont confrontés à une autre difficulté : ce type de publications est avant tout une presse identitaire, que le public acquiert pour retrouver certains repères. La presse spécialisée doit ainsi convaincre ses lecteurs que les définitions précédentes (musicales, mais aussi socioculturelles) qu'elle a elle-même diffusées doivent être remises en cause. Ce d'autant plus qu'à la fin de la décennie, l'apparition des nouvelles technologies (démocratisation de la copie de CD, téléchargements sur Internet) impose un débat public sur le coût de la création musicale, donc une médiatisation plus importante de ses impératifs économiques. Ce travail de recherche s'articule ainsi autour de l'analyse des arguments discursifs employés par les journalistes spécialisés pour médiatiser ce changement

d'identité du rock.

Black/white version. A pervasive shadow of allegations follows Michael Jackson, even in death. Allegations that were never substantiated in any court of law. This book contains primary source material from the FBI, it is hoped that some of the misconceptions surrounding these released files are dispelled and that some assistance is provided to the reader in understanding the outcome of the 2005 trial. It is clear from the contents of the FBI files that 'The FBI Found Nothing.' This outcome was after a decade of forensic, strategic and investigative assistance provided to the local law enforcement agencies. Two-thirds of the released files placed Michael Jackson as the victim of threats and extortion; this is an overlooked fact. Michael Jackson was acquitted of all charges on 13 June 2005. Thereafter, the FBI file was administratively closed. [This book was originally prepared in colour and has been converted to black/white to provide the customer with a choice.]

Few musicals have had the impact of Lerner and Loewe's timeless classic *My Fair Lady*. Sitting in the middle of an era dominated by such seminal figures as Rodgers and Hammerstein, Frank Loesser, and Leonard Bernstein, *My Fair Lady* not only enjoyed critical success similar to that of its rivals but also had by far the longest run of a Broadway musical up to that time. From 1956 to 1962, its original production played without a break for 2,717 performances, and the show went on to be adapted into one of the most successful movie musicals of all time in 1964, when it won eight Academy Awards. Internationally, the show also broke records in London, and the original production toured to Russia at the height of the Cold War in an attempt to build goodwill. It remains a staple of the musical theater canon today, an oft-staged show in national, regional, and high school theaters across the country. Using previously-unpublished documents, author Dominic McHugh presents a completely new, behind-the-

scenes look at the five-year creation of the show, revealing the tensions and complex relationships that went into its making. McHugh charts the show from the aftermath of the premiere of Shaw's *Pygmalion* and the playwright's persistent refusal to allow it to be made into a musical, through to the quarrel that led lyricist Alan Jay Lerner and composer Frederick Loewe to part ways halfway through writing the show, up to opening night and through to the present. This book is the first to shed light on the many behind-the-scenes creative discussions that took place from casting decisions all the way through the final months of frantic preparation leading to the premiere in March 1956. McHugh also traces sketches for the show, looking particularly at the lines cut during the rehearsal and tryout periods, to demonstrate how Lerner evolved the relationship between Higgins and Eliza in such a way as to maintain the delicate balance of ambiguity that characterizes their association in the published script. He looks too at the movie version, and how the cast album and subsequent revivals have influenced the way in which the show has been received. Overall, this book explores why *My Fair Lady* continues to resonate with audiences worldwide more than fifty years after its premiere.

The current state of discographical research in this wide and varied field is such that a research tool of this nature is badly needed. Jesse Walter Fewkes and Mary Hemenway recorded Native American music as early as 1890; Bela Bartok recorded rural music in the Balkans; Erich von Hornbostel, the grand old man of ethnomusicology in Europe, recorded in Southeast Asia. More than just a discography, this work demonstrates that cultures around the world and over time have more similarities than differences.
