Try to make some improvement each day, feeling that it is a pleasure to have conquered that which seemed an impossibility at first. Do not neglect to correct immediately the least fault you make. Bad habits are easily formed, but are difficult to remedy. There are few Celebrated Cornet Soloists, although thousands play the instrument. Most players abuse their practicing by not knowing the proper way, and neglecting to pay more attention to the elementary work. These Studies have been found to be excellent for Clarinet Players as well as Cornet Players. The Clarinet being a Wind Instrument also, all these Exercises will appeal to the Player of that Instrument by following the same instructions.

Während einer Rundreise durch Syrien im Jahr 2010 trifft er in Damaskus unverhofft auf seinen alten Widersacher, einen Grabräuber, der als *Der Blaue Fuchs* bekannt ist. Seine Mitreisenden drängen Ari mehr über seine erste Begegnung mit dem rücksichtslosen Ganoven und dem Leben unter Beduinen zu erzählen.
